- **BACKGROUND**
 - First looked as existing Natural Gas Infrastructure
 - Supply (how existing NG is extracted, transported)
 - How NG enters Florida
 - End use market
 - Transportation Application (8 existing public stations in Florida)
 - Residential, commercial and industrial applications

- **PROBLEM STATEMENT**
 - How do we leverage low cost of NG across Florida Energy Economy?
 - Transportation sector expansion, done through four ways:
 - LNG
 - CNG
 - Rail
 - Marine
 - Pairing NG with renewables (fuel cells, turbines)
 - Solar with NG tankless
 - Solar Electric with NG fueled DG technology
 - Bio-gas/landfill gas integration into NG infrastructure

- **BENEFITS**
 - Diversity leads to reliability
 - Job creation and increased manufacturing (lower cost per unit produced)
