NEEDS: **Energy, Water** and Food

- Solar heating
- Solar Cooling
- Concentrated solar power (CSP)
- Co-location of Solar + Conventional Power Plants
- Thermal Storage

Recommendation for SUS Proposal

- Combined power and fresh water production system including energy storage
 - 1. Solar/Desalination/Storage system stand alone
 - 2. Solar integrated with conventional system
 - 3. Water desalination useful by products Chloride (50%), Sodium (30%), Sulphate (7%), etc.

By products can be used for PCM thermal storage, as commodity materials, etc.

Benefits to the State of Florida

- Use of local resources (reduction of fossil fuels)
- Decrease environmental pollution
- Mitigate the problem of water shortage
- Sustainable
